

RALLY ROADBOOK WAYPOINTS



WAYPOINTS		SUMMARY
	WAYPOINT MASKED	A compulsory WP whose coordinates are not revealed to participants. The GPS directs to this point once arrived within a radius of 300 m. of it. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
	WAYPOINT CONTROL	A compulsory WP to check that the Roadbook has been respected, with no navigation information being supplied by the Roadbook. A WPC will never be placed off track. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
	WAYPOINT SAFETY	A compulsory WP, used to ensure participants' safety, whose coordinates are normally not revealed to participants. The GPS directs to this point once arrived within a radius of 300 m. of it. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
	WAYPOINT NAVIGATION	A compulsory WP used to prevent pilots to avoid challenging routes or navigation difficulties especially off piste, with no navigation information being supplied by the Roadbook. The GPS directs to this point once arrived within a radius of 300 m. of it. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
	WAYPOINT PRICISE	A compulsory WP to check that the Roadbook has been accurately respected, with no navigation information being supplied by the Roadbook. The GPS directs to this point once arrived within a radius of 150 m. of it. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
	WAYPOINT ECLIPSE	A compulsory WP whose coordinates are not revealed to participants. It becomes completely visible once the preceding waypoint has been validated. The GPS directs to this point once arrived within a radius of 300 m. of it. To validate it you must pass within 20 m. of it.
